This law created a program of Trade Adjustment Assistance (called TAA) to help individuals who become unemployed as a result of increased imports to return to suitable employment. This law was amended on August 6, 2002 creating the Trade Reform Act of 2002. The Trade and Globalization Adjustment Assistance Act of 2009 was part of the "Recovery Act" and made changes to the TAA program again and apply ONLY to those petitions FILED on or after May 18, 2009. Most recently the TAA extension Act of 2011 has change the 2009 Act for petitions filed as of February 13, 2011

The Trade Programs provide for reemployment services and allowances for eligible individuals. These services and allowances may include:
